Those not present were Katrina Nixon, Jessica Pitford and Pastor Cristian Reyes. The meeting was called to order by Charles and Pastor Dan offered the opening prayer.

The minutes of the May meeting were discussed and corrections were made. Troy made a motion to accept the minutes as corrected. Mandy seconded the motion which was then passed.

The financial reports were reviewed and discussed. Craig made a motion to accept the reports which was seconded by Jamie. The motion carried.

OLD BUSINESS:

Pastor Dan said he will have a referral put in the newsletter about the safe sanctuary policy video which is fifteen minutes in length.

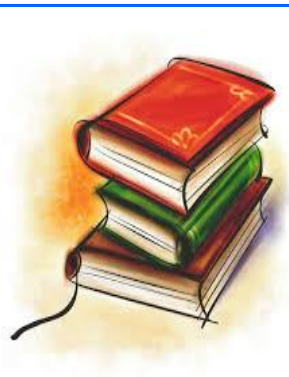

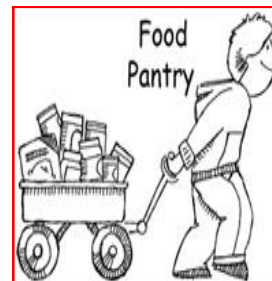
