Greetings St. Paul!!

Easter is this month believe it or not, so I thought a few words about the Easter Lily might be appropriate and interesting.

The beautiful lily has long been associated with springtime, and the idea of new life. It's a natural choice to use in decorating our churches at Easter.

Jesus speaks of lilies in the Sermon On The Mount and compared them to King Solomon's royal clothing: "Consider the lilies how they grow: they toil not, they spin not: and yet I say unto you, that Solomon in all his glory was not arrayed like one of these." (Luke 12:27)

The flower is sometimes called the "white-robed apostle of hope" as it has been featured in several Christian legends.

One is that after Jesus agony in the Garden of Gethsemane, lilies were found growing where drops of the Lord's sweat fell to the ground during His prayers.

A companion legend is that lilies grew around Christ's tomb wherever the resurrected Lord stepped.

In some paintings, the angel Gabriel is pictured extending to Mary a branch of pure white lilies as he makes the announcement that she is to be the mother of the Christ Child.

Because the lily is such a familiar and powerful symbol of the resurrection, it is traditional for them to be displayed on Easter Sunday, but not before. (It wouldn't be appropriate to display resurrection symbols before then.) When you walk into the church on Easter morning, you are greeted by the wonderful and symbolic Easter Lily.

May your Easter be blessed, and may the blessings of our Resurrected Lord be with us all.

<u>Election of Consistory Members</u>: President - Jaime Ross, Vice President - Craig Hunziker, Secretary - Dana Bush, Treasurer - Katrina Nixon, Financial Secretary - Mandy Ross, Ushers -Brian Clark & Ava Little, Building and Grounds -Mike Frazier, Member At Large – Jessica Pitford. These officer nominations will need to be accepted at the annual meeting held on January 21, 2024 following worship service.

New Business:

- 1. Furnace replacement The furnace in the southwest corner of the church had to be replaced as it stopped working. The bill for the cost for the new furnace and labor has not yet arrived.
- 2. Church Elevator The elevator company was supposed to do an inspection the first week of January. We are still waiting for an elevator inspection.
- Annual Congregational Meeting Agenda items for the annual meeting were discussed.
 The spending limit without congregational approval is suggested to be set at \$5,000.
 The congregation should consider reviewing the bylaws annually.
- 4. Donations to the Iowa Southeast Conference are suggested but not required. Donations are based on a church's member count. Discussion was raised on how we would accurately determine our church's membership, specifically legacy members versus current members. We are the largest church in our Association.

Mandy Ross motioned to approve the slate as presented contingent upon congregational approval. Ava Little seconded the motion. The motion was voted on and approved by all members.

Easter Sure Was Early This Year! - With Easter on March 31 this year, I was asked if Easter is often this early. Back in 2008, Easter fell on March 23! And in 2027 and 2032, it will fall on March 28th.

Maundy Thursday - March 28th - This year's Maundy Thursday service will be on March 28th at 7:00 p.m. It will be special because the current Confirmation Class will receive their first communion together. This is always a special service, and if you can not attend I hope you will add your prayers to this blessed day.

How To Pray - On Good Friday (March 29th) at 7:00 p.m., there will not be a service of worship at the church, but Pastor Dan will give a brief, informal talk about different ways to pray, giving examples from across the history and breadth of the Church. The talk will give you tools for your "prayer toolbox". Some you may find useful, some you may never use. But you will have them if you need them. Anyone is welcome to attend.

Easter Bunny - Just a reminder to everyone that the Easter Bunny will be attending our Easter Egg Hunt on Easter Sunday, and would be more than happy to pose for pictures.

Heifer Project Special Collection - Our Sunday School kids have begun their annual collection for the Heifer Project.

The Heifer Project began with a simple idea. In 1938 an Indiana farmer named Dan West was passing out cups of milk to refugee children during the Spanish Civil War. Then an idea struck him—"These children don't need a cup of milk, they need a cow."

When West was back home in Indiana, he took this idea to his neighbors and his church. By 1939, the Heifers for Relief Committee had been formed. From a man's single idea, generations of folk around the world have received a hand up and been blessed by the work of the Heifer Project.

Our kids will be collecting loose change (and folding money, too) for the Heifer Project now through March 17th. Their goal this year is \$500.

March Sermon Texts - Here are some of the Bible texts I am planning on using this month. (They may change.) March 3 will be John 2:13-22; March 10 will be John 3:14-21; March 17 will be John 12:20-33. I have not decided on my Palm Sunday texts yet (March 24), Easter (March 31) John 20:1-10.
