St. Paul United Church of Christ Consistory Minutes October 15, 2023

The consistory met at 8:30 am at the church. Those present were Charles Krueger, Troy Hamner, Jamie Ross, Gloria Macomber, Mandy Ross, Ava Little, Katrina Nixon, Jessica Pitford, Pastor Dan Moore and Pastor Cristian Reyes. President Charles called the meeting to order and Pastor Dan gave the opening prayer.

The minutes of the September 17 meeting were reviewed. Ava made a motion to accept the minutes as read and it was seconded by Mandy. The motion was carried.

The Financial reports were reviewed. Those reviewed and discussed were the Profit & Loss Budget vs. Actual for January through September, 2023, the Treasurer's Report as of October 15, 2023, and the Farm Report for the month of September, 2023.

We have received the landscape bill of \$1,135.00 from Kendra Wettstein. The work was very good. Ava made a motion to pay Kendra \$1,400.00 from the memorial fund. Jamie seconded the motion and the motion carried. A transfer of \$10,000.00, as previously discussed, has been made from the farm account to the general account.

We discussed the amount paid to Kathy Wilson, as pianist, which she consistently donates back to the church. Mandy made a motion to add that amount for the rest of this year to Emily Reyes for her work leading the praise band. Troy seconded the motion and the motion passed.

Jamie made a motion to accept the financial reports. The motion was seconded by Troy and was passed.

OLD BUSINESS:

Pastor Cristian gave a report on how the youth group is at present. He commented the attendance at the Sunday night meetings are somewhat less than those previously at the Wednesday meetings. That is likely to improve with time.

Pastor Dan talked about the confirmand group. There are thirteen confirmands. At present the two adults helping are Denise Moore and Pastor Cristian.

NEW BUSINESS:

The elevator continues to have problems and works with difficulty. A new circuit board has been ordered.

Mandy is continuing the search for the best church insurance. She has been in contact with an insurer which seems promising on meeting our preferred needs.

We discussed the need to replace three current consistory members whose terms will end this year.

We were requested to be thinking about the 2024 church budget.

Pastor Dan reported he will be out of town from Monday thru Saturday this next week but can be reached by phone.

We were advised of a cleaning problem in the sanctuary caused by the use of live rose petals during a wedding. Katrina made a motion that only artificial petals be used at church weddings. Troy seconded the motion and it was passed.

We were told of a request for our church to place an ad on the 2024 law enforcement calendar magnet. We agreed that we did not want to have an ad.


