Recently, I reintroduced the candle & rosebud ceremony for infants back into the life of the congregation. I know it has been awhile, but it seemed like the time had come to pull the idea out of mothballs and try it again.

Unfortunately, I could not find anything about what used to be done before I got here in September of 2020. We had a few rosebuds and candles in the office, but I couldn't find anything about what I was to do with them or what was to be said. And I looked!

So after running some ideas past some people, this is what I have reconstructed. When a new child comes to church for the first time (And I know about it ahead of time.) we will call the child and their family to come forward during worship. I will read a short reflection that I put together, and will gift them with a rosebud and a candle—blue for boys and pink for girls. That way, we all have a chance to welcome the little one into the life of our church.

This can either be a stand alone ceremony or a part of the baptismal service. I made sure it could work both ways.

It know it's not what we used to do, but it's what we will try and do going forward. So when a new baby is to come to worship for the very first time, let the church know and everything will be all set up.

It is always a blessing to have new little ones in the church. And it is a wonderful tradition to welcome them. I am glad we will have the opportunity to do so in the future.




